

Behaviour Policy Addendum - COVID -19

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, it is paramount that all of the rules must be adhered to.

Failure to comply will result in the student being asked to leave school immediately.

- All students when moving around the school must follow the specific instructions (for example, follow the direction of staff and move straight to the next lesson; this also applies when entering and exiting the building).
- Everyone must follow the school's instructions on hygiene, such as hand washing and sanitising.
- Everyone must wear masks in the building as instructed. Only students with formal exemption will be permitted to use a visor instead.
- Everyone must follow the social distancing guidelines (2 metres) at all times.
- If you are experiencing symptoms of the coronavirus when in school, you must inform a member of staff immediately.
- Students must NOT share any equipment or other items including drinking bottles at any time.
- Student MUST only use the toilets one at a time and follow the hygiene guidelines.
- Spitting and coughing at an individual will not be tolerated and should any instances
 be witnessed the individual will be asked to leave the premises with immediate effect.
 The police may also be contacted.
- Students who display aggressive or violent behaviour that forces staff to physically intervene might be asked to leave and be placed on remote learning as an alternative.
- Students that are remote working from home will be supplied with work, paper-based and/or online, and there is the expectation that all work should be completed and returned to the school.
- The school will continue to record behaviour data and communicate with students and parents as normal.
